My pledges to you

Tory failures since May's election

✗ Pledged not to build on the green belt and then proposed 500 houses

The Tories' election campaign was based around not building on the green belt, but they have now submitted plans for 500 homes and a large industrial site. Not only that, the meeting where these plans would be approved has been conveniently moved back to a week after the by-election to try and dupe residents about their intentions even further.

✗ Didn't stand up for Toton on fracking

Fracking has the potential to affect vast areas of the green belt in Broxtowe with plans to drill deep under our homes. The Tories had the chance to oppose this but they failed to.

✗ Gave away control of our leisure centres

The Tories have chosen to spend £100,000 taking our leisure centres outside of local authority control. In the future, they could well be run by a private company and we would have no say in what happens.

✗ Threatened to close every single public toilet

The Tories have proposed to close all of the borough's public toilets.
