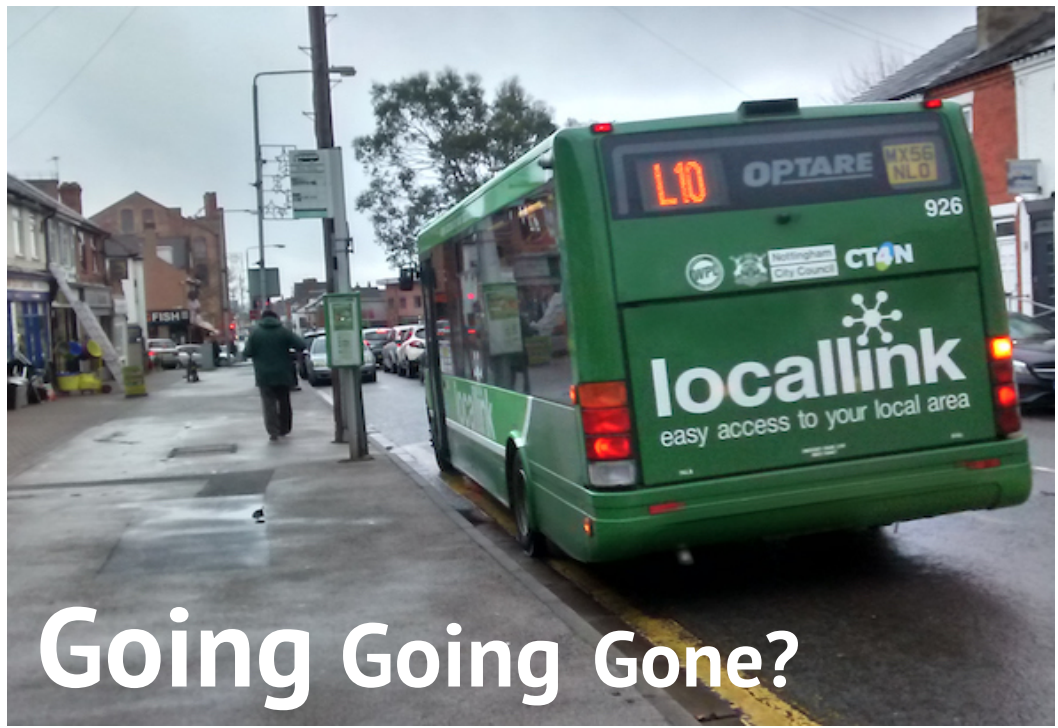

More Trolleys More Buggies?

Why Ellie and Labour want a bus for all ages which is reliable, affordable and comfortable

'I can't drive a car, so buses matter to me and living in Beeston Fields now and, before that, in Bramcote I know how important the little buses are. It would great if they ran every 30 minutes and into the evenings too, so that we can go and meet friends, or visit the new cinema, and get home afterwards without having to hire a taxi.

Listening to what people say, I know that there are drawbacks — not always enough space on the bus for buggies or others with shopping trollies. This only has to happen a couple of times and you give up on the bus!

I will work hard to persuade all our local bus operators to re-arrange some of the seating, so their buses can carry more wheelchairs, buggies and shopping trollies.

Then there's waiting in the cold and the rain. ALL bus stops should have shelters which protect us from the weather and be lit when

it's dark. These things matter and I will fight for them I promise. In the meantime I've been working with bus users I know to come up with a proposal to make sure we still have at least an hourly bus linking us to Beeston, increasing to every 30 minutes as more of us use the bus.

The possible route shown opposite will take c.22 minutes from Bramcote Lane to Beeston.' *Ellie.*
